You're just moments away from enjoying your new Montford MFDP12 digital piano.

Your new Montford MFDP12 digital piano has two very special features:

A 88 Note, Graded Hammer Action Keyboard:

This means that your Montford digital piano will feel just like a real acoustic piano. That's really important when playing, practising or performing as your fingers will get stronger; the keys will respond properly to more advanced techniques; and when you play an acoustic piano in the future, it will feel much more familiar.

An incredible Grand Piano tone from DREAM:

This remarkable sound chip from the French music tech company, DREAM, gives you a truly excellent piano sound, previously reserved for only the most exclusive digital pianos. Close your eyes and you'd think you were playing a full sized grand piano. It's really that good!

1. Assemble your new Montford Digital Piano.

- *Caution* We recommend that two people are present for assembly.
- Follow the assembly instructions, taking care to assemble as shown on the opposite page.
- We estimate that assembly of the piano stand will take no more than 30 mins from start to finish.
- You will need a cross-head screwdriver.

2. Connect the Pedals to the Piano:

- As part of the piano stand you have 3 integrated expression pedals.
- These pedals are connected to the main piano keyboard via a 5 pin cable which trails from the pedal board of the stand.
- This socket is located underneath the piano, to the left. Not on the back panel.

3. Turn the piano 'ON':

- To keep the aesthetic clean and simple, the power button is located UNDER the left hand side of the front of the piano.
- Just feel for the switch, and 'flick'! You're good to go.

4. Adjust the volume:

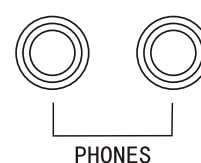
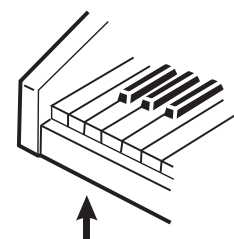
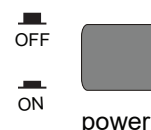
- Next to the power switch, under the front left hand side of the piano is the volume control.
- Turn this rotary knob to the left to decrease volume, and to the right to increase the volume.

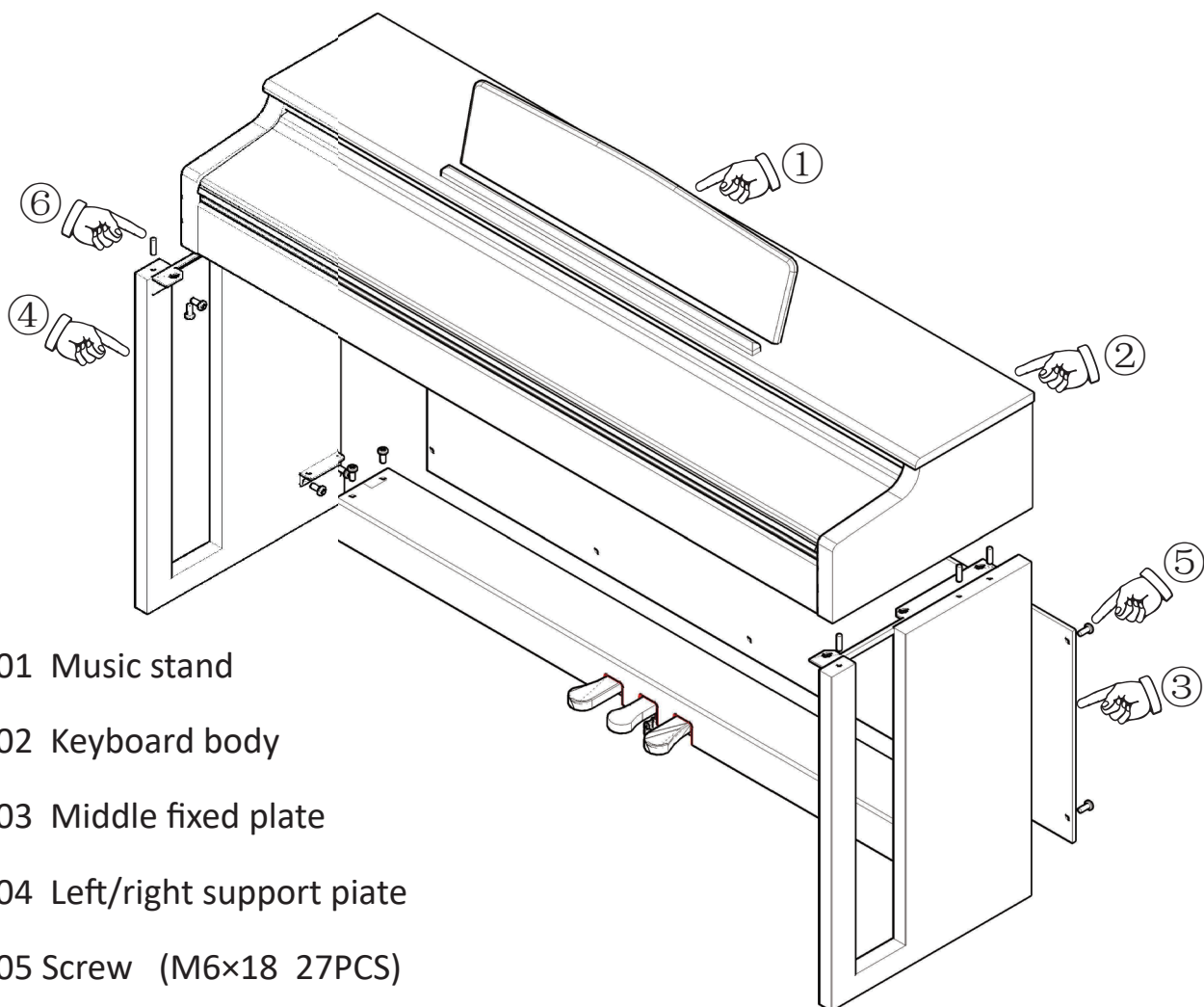
5. Listen on Headphones:

- For silent practise - and even silent lessons too (!) - you can plug headphones into the back of the piano. Note: When using headphones, the speakers are muted, so no one else can hear.
- As the Montford MFDP12 is equipped with 2 headphone sockets, both you and a chosen companion or teacher can play or practise without disturbing anyone else!
- The headphone sockets are located underneath the piano to the left-hand side, adjacent to the power switch and volume control.

6. Connect your Montford Digital Piano to a Computer or Tablet.

- Also on the back of the piano is a MIDI USB connector. Using the appropriate cable, you can connect your piano to your computer to control other music equipment or to record into a Digital Audio Workstation (DAW).





01 Music stand

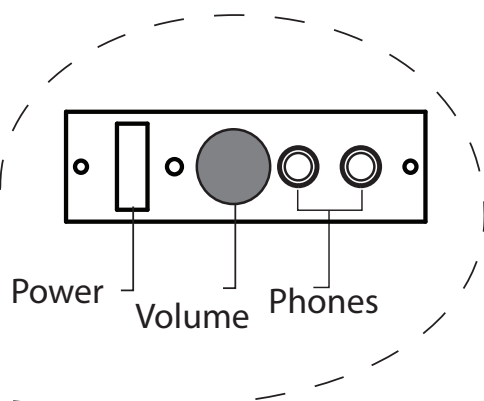
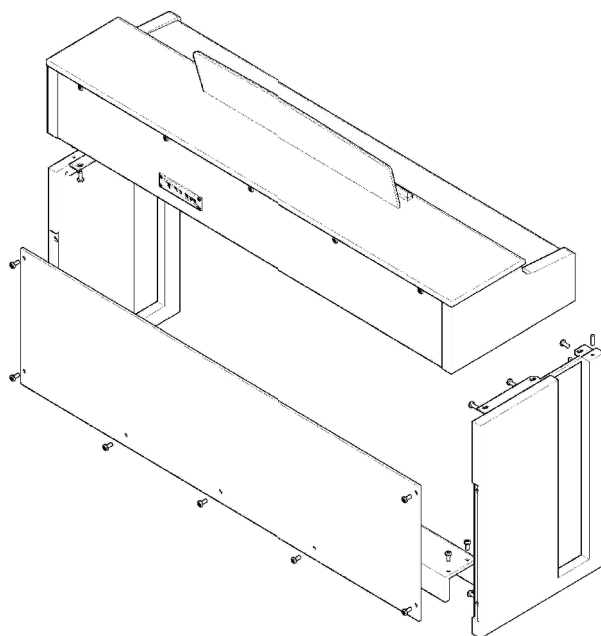
02 Keyboard body

03 Middle fixed plate

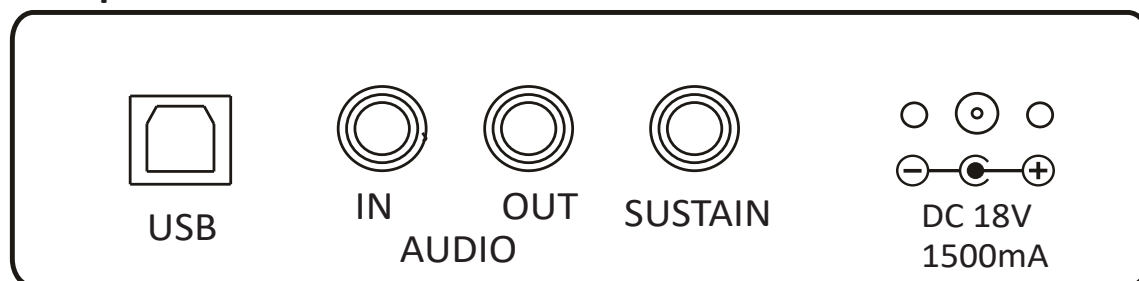
04 Left/right support plate

06 Wooden bolt (6×30 6PCS)

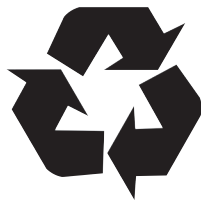


Back panel overview:
